

Yard Waste Collection Guidelines – 2010

Carroll County Waste Services

Yard waste cannot be included with trash taken to the Carroll County Landfill. We offer a separate yard waste collection service for our customers. Yard waste is taken to an area of the landfill where it is mulched and recycled. Beginning in 2007, Carroll County regulations require that yard waste no longer be placed in plastic bags. Heavy paper bags are available for purchase locally at Walmart and Home Depot as well as other stores.

Please be sure to place your yard waste out on Thursday night as we begin collection very early on Friday mornings.

Yard waste will be collected on the following Fridays...

April 16, 30, May 14, 28, June 11, 25, July 9, 23,
August 6, 20, September 3, 17, October 1, 15, 29,
November 12 (**NO pick up Nov. 26**) & December 3

Guidelines for collection...

- Leaves and grass should be placed in paper bags weighing no more than 40 lbs each
- Sticks, twigs, branches and vines must be bundled and tied with string or bagged
- Branches and limbs cannot be larger than 3 inches in diameter and 4 ½ feet long

The following items cannot be collected with yard waste

- Soil
- Lumber
- Wood chips
- mulch
- Animal Waste
- Plastic or other non-biodegradable packaging
